▶ 1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games will be the largest multi-sport event to take place in the UK this decade, with athletes from throughout the Commonwealth showcasing their skills and talents in a unique festival of sporting competition.

Birmingham 2022's Games Family Services Team, in conjunction with the Sport Team, have produced this Flag Manual as a guide, to ensure the correct protocols and procedures are applied to the display and raising of flags throughout Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games.

Primarily, this Flag Manual is a visual reference guide for identifying flags associated with the Commonwealth Games nations and territories and their approved manner for display. It provides details of the Protocol flags required by the Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF), the flags of each participating Commonwealth Games Association (CGA), and the identified flags of each International Sport Federation (IF), including, where applicable, the Relevant Para Sport Federation Flag.

All flags represented in this Flag Manual have been approved by the relevant CGA, CGF and IF to ensure the correct design, colours and orientation of each flag.

BIRMINGHAM 2022 COMMONWEALTH GAMES FLAG PRESENTATION

Flags to be displayed at the Games, are classified in two groups – Protocol Set Flags and Flags of Nations. Detail regarding the display of each group of flags is in the next section of this Flag Manual and following is a brief description of each type of flag to be displayed at the Games.

1.1. PROTOCOL FLAGS – IN ORDER OF PRECEDENCE

- Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF): The Official Flag of the CGF will comprise of the official emblem of Commonwealth Sport.
- Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games: The Birmingham 2022 Flag will comprise the full colour Games mark centred on a white background.
- International Federations (IFs): The IF flags are the flags of the International Federations for each sport in the Birmingham 2022 sport programme and where applicable, the flag of the International Para Sport Federation.
- Flag of the Host Nation: As host nation, the national flag of England will be displayed in both the Protocol set and the Flags of Nations.

1.2. FLAGS OF NATIONS

The Flags of Nations are the national flags of each participating CGA. In line with CGF obligation GFS07 and outlined throughout this Manual, flags of nations will appear as directed in the main stadium, Commonwealth Games Villages, competition venues and for winning athletes at relevant Medal Ceremonies.

1.3. FLAG SIZE

Flags, particularly the national flags of the CGAs, are traditionally produced in different proportions. We are aiming for uniformity, and all printed flags for the Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games will be produced using a 3:2 ratio (3:2 ratio meaning two times deep to three times the length, with the exception of the flags of Anguilla and Sri Lanka, which will be flown in a 2:1 ratio).

The flags will also be produced in three sizes to support operational implementation:

- 1800mm x 1200 mm
- 4710mm x 3410mm for use at Opening & Closing Ceremonies
- Where required, a venue specific size given space/overlay constraints.

1.4. PROTOCOL FOR DISPLAY OF FLAGS AT VENUES

The Commonwealth Games Federation GFS07 states: “The flags of the participating nations and of the Commonwealth Games must be displayed in the main stadium and Commonwealth Games Villages. They must be displayed in alphabetical order of the Host Country. At other competition venues the Flags of Nations and territories taking part in that particular sport and of the Commonwealth Games shall be displayed.”

At Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games, flags will be displayed from left to right starting with the Protocol flags followed by the national flags in alphabetical order (by nation). There will be a space of one Flag width between the Protocol flags and Flags of Nations.

The national flag of England will be the only flag displayed twice, once as part of the Protocol set, and again in the national flags in last position as the host nation, where they participate in a sport competition.

1.4.1. Competition Venues

At all competition venues, a set of Protocol flags (including the relevant IF flag) will be displayed followed by the national flags of each nation competing in the respective sport at that venue, in alphabetical order.

There will be a space of one flag width between the Protocol flags and Flags of Nations.

The order of the Protocol set at each competition venue is as follows:

- Commonwealth Games Federation
- Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games
- International Federations (IFs) and where applicable, the flag of the International Para Sport Federation
- National flag for host nation England

If a late change is identified for a sport after the national flags have been installed at the competition venue(s), the best endeavours will be made to include the flag for that competing nation or territory in the correct alphabetical order.

Whilst we are aware no Russian or Belarussian athletes will participate in competitions, it is possible that a current sporting records/sporting great maybe of those nationalities. Due to the current conflict in Ukraine, it has been agreed that in presentations, broadcasts, or as part of competitors' attire Russian or Belarussian flags should be not displayed.

1.4.2. Commonwealth Games Villages (CGVs)

At the three Commonwealth Games Villages: Commonwealth Games Village Birmingham, Commonwealth Games Village Warwick and Commonwealth Village NEC, the Protocol set of flags will be as follows:

- Commonwealth Games Federation
- Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games
- National flag for host nation England

The national flags of all 72 competing CGAs will also be displayed at the CGVs. Each nation or territory's flag will be raised during their Team Welcome Ceremony, and the Flags of Nations will also be displayed. As host nation, the national flag of England will be displayed in last position.

1.4.3. Games Family Hotel (GFH) – The Grand Hotel

At the Games Family Hotel, no flags will be displayed internally or externally due to space constraints.

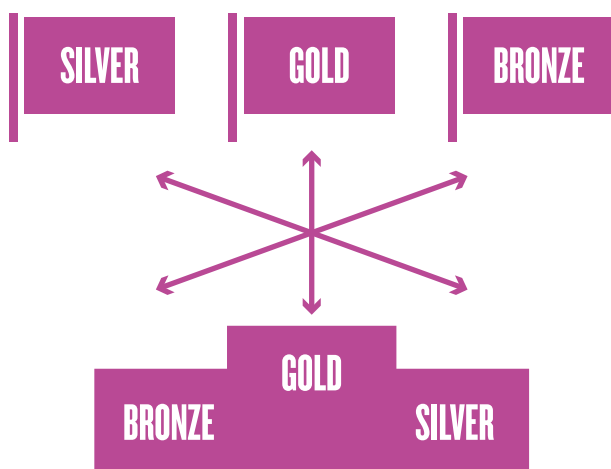
No flags are proposed to be on display at other non-competition venues during Games Time.

1.5. MEDAL CEREMONIES

1.5.1. Display of Flags at Medal Ceremonies

The national flag of each medallist will be displayed during the relevant medal ceremony.

The order for the display of flags for each medal ceremony, at all indoor and outdoor competition venues, when viewed from the athletes' position on the will be as follows:



The raising of flags for Medal Ceremonies will be as follows:

- Indoor competition venues: flags will be displayed in a trapeze manner in a horizontal format
- Outdoor competition venues: flags will be displayed on a flagpole in a horizontal format

Every precaution will be made against an error in the display of the national flags; however, human or technical errors can result in a mistake being made. An error when raising a flag would be clear, obvious and immediately recognised by the relevant member of staff. It may include the wrong flag being used, or the right flag used but raised with an incorrect orientation.

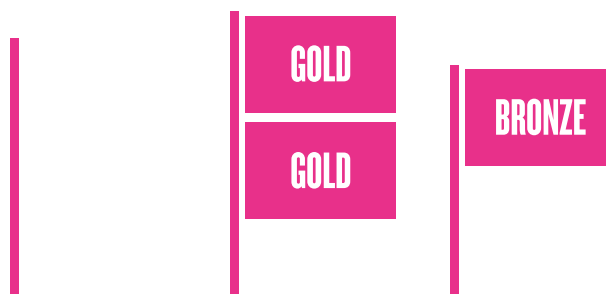
In the event of an error with a flag, procedure GPRO-SPP-004 will be followed. This procedure captures the process that will be followed depending on when an error is identified to the Venue Protocol Manager on venue.

1.5.2. Tied Placing

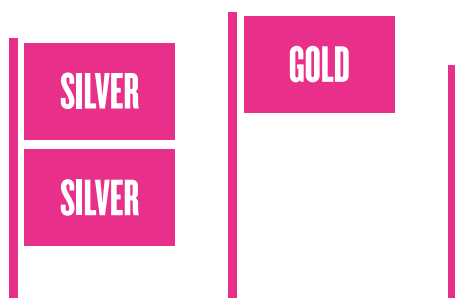
Standard flag protocol states that two flags should not be flown from the same pole; however an exception can be made to the protocol when equal placing for medals occurs. In this instance, two national flags may be hung on the same flagpole or trapeze according to the alphabetical order.

In Boxing, Judo and Wrestling special consideration needs to be paid as a double bronze is guaranteed. In these three sports, bronze medal flags must be hung on a horizontal plane.

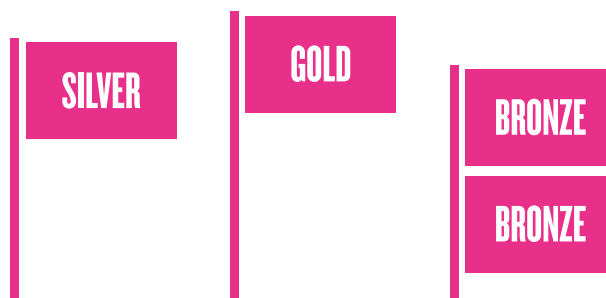
Tie for Gold Medal

1.6. SIGN-OFF OF CGA FLAGS OF NATIONS

Prior to this Manual, all CGAs were provided with the designs of their nation or territory's flag to verify and approve the colour and orientation for final production. The approved designs of all national flags are in Section 4.0. of this Manual.

1.7. DEATH OF A GAMES FAMILY MEMBER

There are no prescribed Commonwealth Games Federation Protocols regarding the lowering of flags in the event of a death of a Games Family member during the Games. As all flags are proposed to be installed in Birmingham 2022 venues to remain in a fixed position, in the event that a death does occur during the Games Period, the CGF Executive Board will decide on the protocol for lowering flags and seek support from the Organising Committee to implement accordingly, where lowering of flags can be facilitated operationally and without impact on the conduct of competition. The Games Operations Centre (GOC)/Protocol Co-Ordination Centre will communicate any agreed arrangements to the Functional Areas and venues as required.

1.8. PRINCIPLES AND ETIQUETTE FOR DISPLAYING FLAGS

1.8.1. Displaying Flags at Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games

Flags at Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games will be displayed in a horizontal format on either installed flagpoles or other truss devices within a venue.

1.8.2. Vertical Display of Flags

No flags will be displayed vertically during the Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games.

1.8.3. Lighting of Flags at Night

Noting the unique Games environment, for operational purposes, no flags are proposed to be lowered at night.

Where possible, flags displayed at night may be illuminated by existing ambient and security lighting, which will support the proposal for the flags to remain in place.

1.8.4. General Notes on Flag Etiquette

The following additional considerations relating to flag protocol, specifically in a Games environment, are outlined as follows:

- Flags should always be treated with the respect and dignity they deserve.
- Flags should not be displayed in any orientation, outside of the approved orientation detailed within this Manual.
- Flags should always be displayed aloft and free and not be allowed to fall or lie on the ground.
- Flags should be displayed as close as possible to the top of the flag mast, with the rope tightly secured.
- Flags should be raised briskly and lowered ceremoniously.
- Flags should never be displayed when damaged, faded or dilapidated.
- When flags are raised or lowered, all present should face the flag and remain silent. Those in uniform should salute.
- Two flags should not be displayed from the same flagpole, except for when equal placing for medals occurs.
